All fees must be paid as per the schedule displayed on the school notice board.

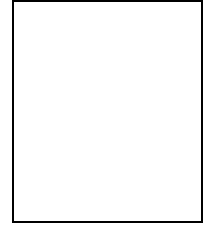

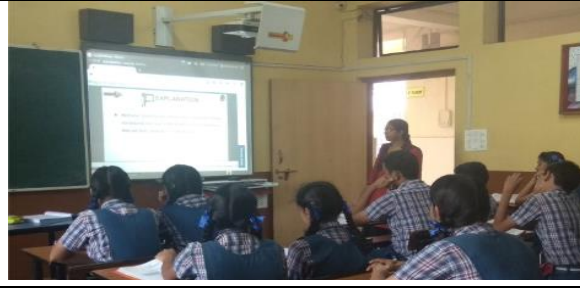
